AREAS A1, A2, A3, B4 (CSU Golden Four) require a C- grade or better.

### **CSU GE CERTIFICATION**

To obtain a Bachelor's degree from a CSU campus, a student must complete 48 units of general education. A community college can certify 39 of these units as having fulfilled the CSU lower division general education requirements. The remaining 9 units of upper-division general education coursework are to be taken at the CSU campus after transfer. CSUGE Certification refers to the official notification provided by LAHC that a student transferring to any CSU campus has completed courses fulfilling CSU lower-division general education requirements. Certification is not automatic. For further information, please consult a LAHC College counselor or with the Admissions and Records Office.

**CSU GE for STEM is (partial certification) only allowed for an approved STEM Associate Degree for Transfer (ADT) Degree.** Students must confirm the CSU major, program, or college that they are applying for accept partial CSUGE certification. Although CSUGE for STEM is an option, students should prioritize completing major-preparation courses for the specific campuses and programs they are considering.

**CSUGE Breadth for STEM (33 units)**: **Only permitted for an approved Associate Degree for Transfer (ADT Degree).** The CSUGE Breadth for STEM can <u>only</u> be applied to the **Biology, Chemistry, and Environmental Science** ADT Degrees. The CSUGE for STEM requires:

Area A: 9 semester units/12 quarter units; one course from A1, one course from A2, and one course from A3.

**Area B**: 9 semester units/12 quarter units; one course from B1, one course from B2, and one course from B3 (if not met in B1/B2), and one course from B4

Area C: 6 semester units/9 quarter units; one course from C1 and one course from C2

Area D: 3 semester units/4 quarter units by selecting one course

Area E: 3 semester units/4 quarter units by selecting one course

Area F: 3 semester units/4 quarter units by selecting one course.

#### DOUBLE-COUNTING

Double counting within other areas of CSUGE is not allowed. Although a course may be listed in more than one subject area, a single course may be used just once.

#### AP Scores

AP Scores of 3, 4, or 5 can be used to satisfy any <u>CSUGE subject area where acceptable</u>. AP exam credit may be listed in more than one area; however, it can be used to satisfy only one GE area. Each campus in the CSU system determines how it will apply external examinations toward credit in the major.

#### **IB Scores**

A score of 5, 6, or 7 on the Higher-Level exams is required to grant credit for <u>CSUGE Breadth certification</u>. An acceptable IB score for CSUGE equates to either 3 semester or 4 quarter units for certification purposes. Students who have earned credit from an IB exam should not take a comparable college course, as transfer credit cannot be granted for both. Please see an LAHC Counselor for approved courses.

#### **COURSES COMPLETED AT OTHER COLLEGES**

1) Courses from other California Community Colleges (CCCs) can have these courses "passed along" in the certification process. LAHC will certify courses taken at other CCCs in the subject areas designated by the offering college.

2) Courses taken at other regionally accredited colleges (in-state, out-of-state, private, public) will be evaluated by counseling faculty or the Articulation Officer.

3) Courses completed at Foreign institutions (without U.S. regional accreditation) cannot be used for CSUGE certification.
