## **IMPORTANT INFORMATION**

### **THE GOLDEN 4**

AREAS A1, A2, A3, B4 (CSU Golden Four) require a C- grade or better.

### **CSU GE CERTIFICATION**

To obtain a Bachelor's degree from a CSU campus, a student must complete 48 units of general education. A community college can certify 39 of these units as having fulfilled the CSU lower division general education requirements. The remaining 9 units of upper-division general education coursework are to be taken at the CSU campus after transfer. CSUGE Certification refers to the official notification provided by LAHC that a student transferring to any CSU campus has completed courses fulfilling CSU lower-division general education requirements. Certification is not automatic. For further information, please consult a LAHC College counselor or with the Admissions and Records Office.

### **PARTIAL CERTIFICATION**

The CSU GE pattern does allow partial certification. Partial certification refers to certification by area (A, B, C, D, E). To be partially certified, a student must complete all courses with an area. The CSU transfer campus will require completion of the general education requirements in those sections that are not certified after transfer.

### **DOUBLE-COUNTING**

Double counting within other areas of CSUGE is not allowed. Although a course may be listed in more than one subject area, a single course may be used just once.

### **CONTINUING STUDENTS (entering before Fall 2021)**

Continuing students (entering before Fall 2021) that maintain continuous enrollment (or catalog rights) are not required to complete Area F. However, continuing students will need to complete 9 semester units from Area D (from at least two different disciplines) for full GE certification and transfer degrees. Please see a counselor for more information.

### **AP SCORES**

AP Scores of 3, 4, or 5 can be used to satisfy any CSUGE subject area where acceptable. AP exam credit may be listed in more than one area; however, it can be used to satisfy only one GE area. Please refer to the LAHC AP Chart in the catalog to confirm how exams can be applied.

### **IB SCORES**

A score of 5, 6, or 7 on the Higher-Level exams is required to grant credit for CSUGE Breadth certification. An acceptable IB score for CSUGE equates to either 3 semester or 4 quarter units for certification purposes. Students who have earned credit from an IB exam should not take a comparable college course, as transfer credit cannot be granted for both. Please see an LAHC Counselor for approved courses.

### **COURSES COMPLETED AT OTHER COLLEGES**

- 1) Courses from other California Community Colleges (CCCs) can have these courses "passed along" in the certification process. LAHC will certify courses taken at other CCCs in the subject areas designated by the offering college.
- 2) Courses taken at other regionally accredited colleges (in-state, out-of-state, private, public) will be evaluated by counseling faculty or the Articulation Officer.
- 3) Courses completed at foreign institutions (without U.S. regional accreditation) cannot be used for CSUGE certification.
