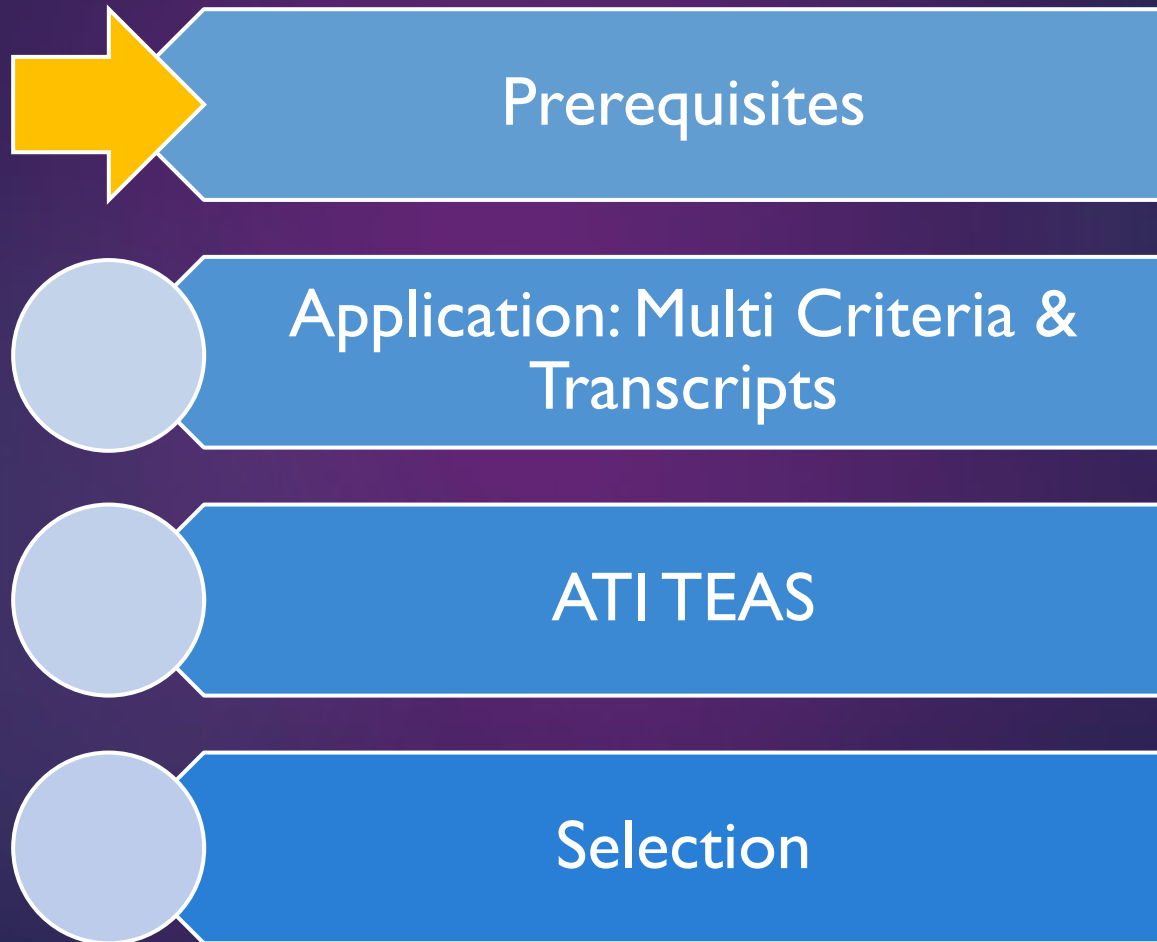

Program Routes

Generic and LVN-RN

- ▶ Both routes require the same course prereqs, general education classes and cumulative and science gpa requirements
- ▶ Generic
 - ▶ Two years, across four semesters
 - ▶ Most common route both fall & spring applications and open to LVN's as well
- ▶ LVN-RN (transition/bridge) fall applications only
 - ▶ Entry into program with advanced placement based upon faculty assessment
 - ▶ Open to actively CA licensed LVNs with 1 year of LVN work experience

Admission Process



Prerequisites: Requirements

- ▶ Proof of education (choose highest applicable)
 - ▶ Graduation from a U.S. accredited high school or equivalent (e.g. GED) OR
 - ▶ Completion of AA or higher degree from a U.S. accredited college or university
 - ▶ Proof shown on official transcripts
 - ▶ ***Copies of diplomas or AA graduation petitions in progress will not be accepted***
- ▶ Social Security Number (SSN) or ITIN #

Prerequisites: Sciences Requirements

- ▶ Grade of “C” or better
 - ▶ Applies to Lecture and Lab
 - ▶ For plus/minus grades, no “C-”
- ▶ Science GPA **2.5** or higher
 - ▶ All “C” grades do not equal 2.5
- ▶ Repeats: No more than ONE substandard grade repeat in the sciences (W’s are not grades)
- ▶ Currently no recency requirement

Co-requisites

- ▶ Series of courses required for degree (A.S. Nursing, Professional)
- ▶ **Highly recommended** to be completed prior to applying to the nursing program
 - ▶ All beneficial for CSU transfer
 - ▶ Some are worth points on the point system for admission

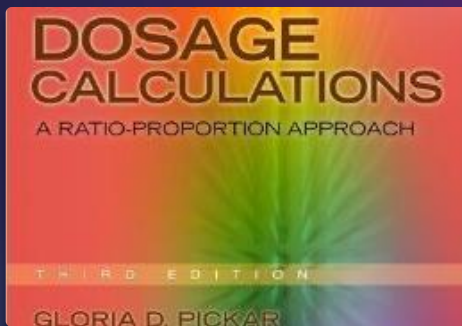

LACCD Ethnic Studies Graduation Requirement:

Only required for students enrolling for the first time at an LACCD college in the fall 2023 term or later (or a returning student) must complete a transfer-level course (3 sem/4 qtr. units with a grade of C or P or higher) in ethnic studies. Students with catalog rights prior to Fall 2023 are NOT required to complete the LACCD Ethnic Studies Graduation Requirement

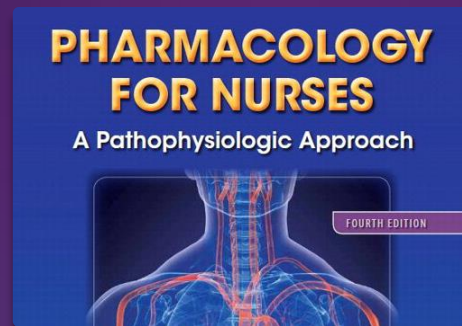

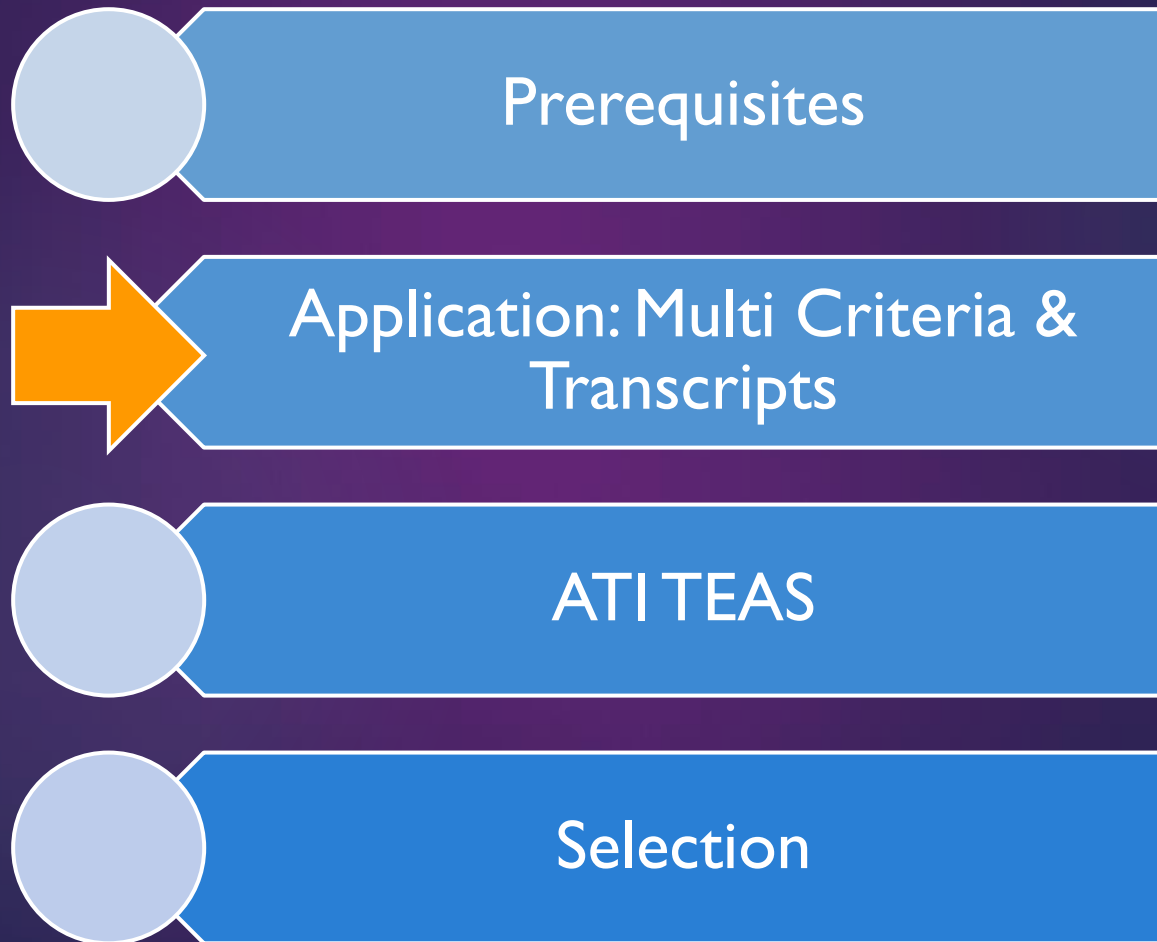

Info for LVNs

- ▶ **LVN-RN Advanced Placement Route** (fall application period only)
 - ▶ Same program requirements as the generic route
 - ▶ Active CA LVN license (provide copy with application) with 1 year of work experience
- ▶ Enroll in Nursing 329A, 329B, 311, 321 at time of application or spring before (fall application period)
- ▶ Entry into Generic route with advanced placement based upon faculty assessment
- ▶ LVN's can also apply in spring however that would be for the generic route via lottery selection process

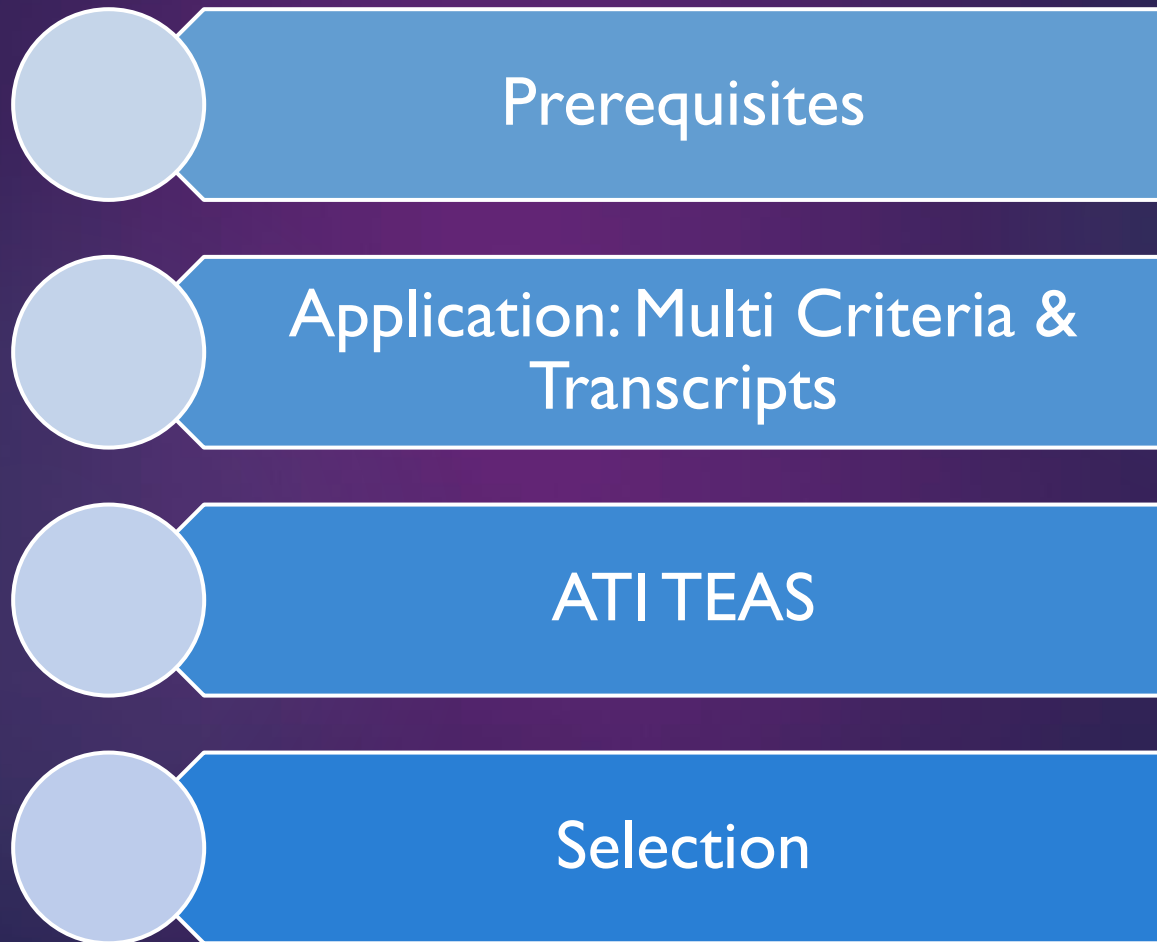

Application: Transcripts

- ▶ **You must submit transcripts from ALL institutions attended**, whether or not related to pre/co-requisites
 - ▶ *Including institutions listed on another institution's transcripts*

Application: High School Transcripts

- ▶ High School transcripts: when to submit?
 - ▶ If you **do not have** a previous degree (AA or higher)
 - ▶ Example 1: High School graduate needs to submit high school transcripts
- ▶ **One copy with application, one copy mailed to Admissions**
- ▶ **Copies of diplomas will not be accepted**

Application: Transcripts *within* LACCD

- ▶ **ONE (1) UN-official transcript**
 - ▶ All LACCD coursework on one transcript
 - ▶ Include with Nursing Application Form
 - ▶ Not required to provide to LAHC Admissions and Records
 - ▶ **Please remember LACCD does not share outside college transcripts within LACCD you must send outside LACCD transcripts directly to LAHC admissions

Application: Transcripts **outside** of LACCD

- ▶ **Print (1) unofficial transcript or official sealed transcript**
 - ▶ Include in Nursing Application packet
 - ▶ Do not mail separately to Nursing Department
- ▶ **Order (1) official transcript**
 - ▶ Send to LAHC Admission and Records
 - ▶ Must be sent directly from institution to LAHC Admissions, do not hand deliver

Application: Transcripts **outside** of LACCD cont.

- ▶ Foreign transcripts
 - ▶ Official sealed transcripts AND official sealed evaluation
 - ▶ Remember to petition courses for equivalency
- ▶ Out-of-state/Private Institution transcripts
 - ▶ Remember to petition courses for equivalency

Application: Petitions

- ▶ ***See a counselor, at your school, to ensure your courses meet admission requirements***
- ▶ If there is no current agreement or articulation of a course between one institution and LAHC, then a petition for course equivalency is required
 - ▶ www.assist.org is a great resource that you can start with on your own

Application: Petitions cont.


- ▶ Majority of CA community college courses do not require petitions
- ▶ Many university courses (CSU, UC) are accepted
- ▶ **Petitions are absolutely required for courses used from**
 - ▶ **Out-of-state institutions**
 - ▶ **Any private institutions**
(e.g. Southern California University of Health Sciences)
 - ▶ **Foreign institutions**

Application: Petitions cont.

- ▶ Petition for course equivalency
 - ▶ See Admissions website for form
 - ▶ Usually include course grade, description, syllabi, etc.
- ▶ ***Submit to Admission and Records, not to individual departments***
 - ▶ <https://www.lahc.edu/admissions/forms-petitions>
 - ▶ Signed off by department chair/administrator

Application: Petitions cont.

- Not a quick process (plan ahead)
- **Must include copy of signed, approved petition OR**
- **TES approval from LAHC articulation officer**

Application: What Happens Next?

- ▶ ***Applications are reviewed and processed AS-IS!***
- ▶ ***Allow 6-8 weeks from submission deadline for evaluation process***
- ▶ All transcripts and attachments become property of the college
- ▶ Initial review by Nursing department for apparent errors
- ▶ Coursework evaluated by Admissions and Records
 - ▶ Verify eligible coursework / calculate GPAs

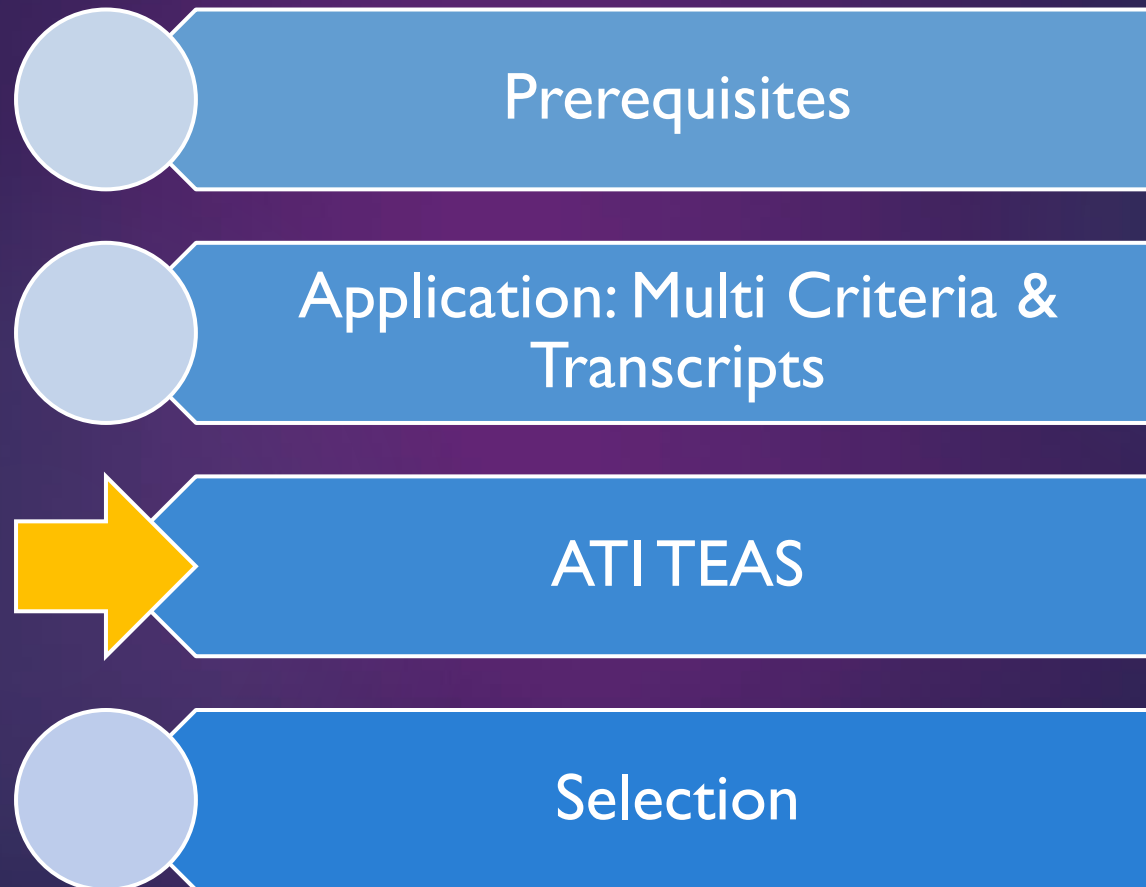

Application: Denied?

- ▶ Incomplete application (*READ ALL INSTRUCTIONS*)
- ▶ Incorrect / misspelled e-mail
- ▶ No signature on form
- ▶ Missing Transcripts
- ▶ Incomplete petitions
- ▶ Low Science or cumulative GPA (<2.5)
- ▶ Too many attempts
- ▶ Application was not answered truthfully
- ▶ Failed TEAS previously
- ▶ Missing student I.D. number

ATI TEAS: What is it?

- ▶ Test of Essential Academic Skills
- ▶ Standardized entrance exam used by this nursing program, covers knowledge in
 - ▶ Reading
 - ▶ Mathematics
 - ▶ Science
 - ▶ English/Language usage
- ▶ 170 questions, 209 minutes
- ▶ <https://www.atitesting.com/teas/exam-details>

- ▶ Applications have been reviewed for eligibility
- ▶ Initial correspondence of eligibility by student email
 - ▶ Eligible: No offers for admission yet, but rather to move forward in admission process
 - ▶ Ineligible: review message, consider to reapply
- ▶ Next step:ATI TEAS

ATI TEAS: Requirements

- ▶ New ATI TEAS (7) June 1, 2022
- ▶ Minimum requirement: **62%** overall
 - ▶ To be replaced by new scoring metric, date TBD
- ▶ ***Only the first attempt accepted***
 - ▶ If taken elsewhere and below 62%, applicant is ineligible to apply at LAHC, despite subsequent higher scores

ATI TEAS: Selection

- ▶ Applicants who have previously taken the ATI TEAS will be instructed to have test results sent from the ATI website directly to “Los Angeles Harbor College”
- ▶ Only the first score is accepted, TEAS deadline is last day of application period you are applying within (see website for date)
- ▶ Previous versions of the ATI TEAS (e.g. TEAS VI) will not be accepted

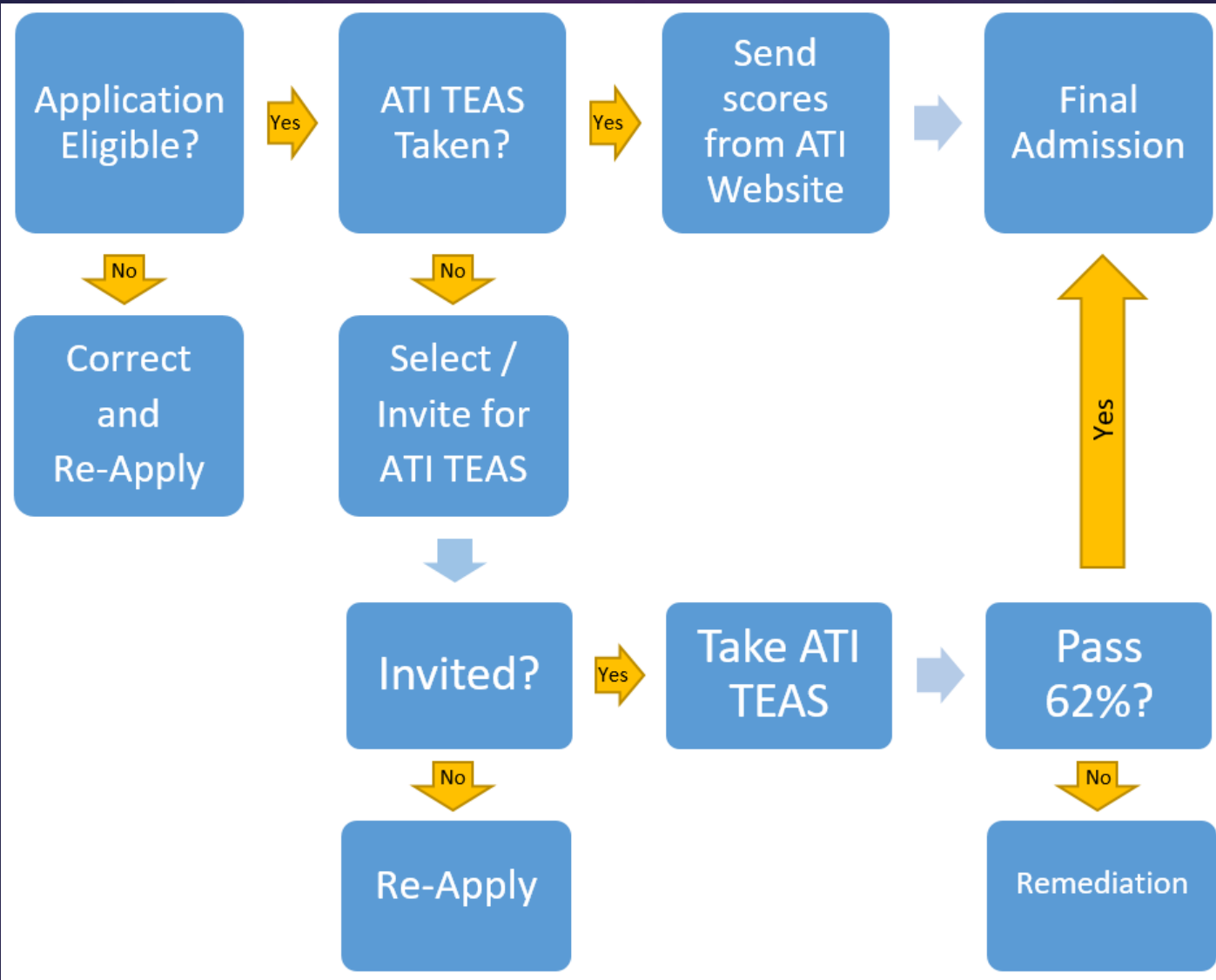

ATI TEAS: Outcome

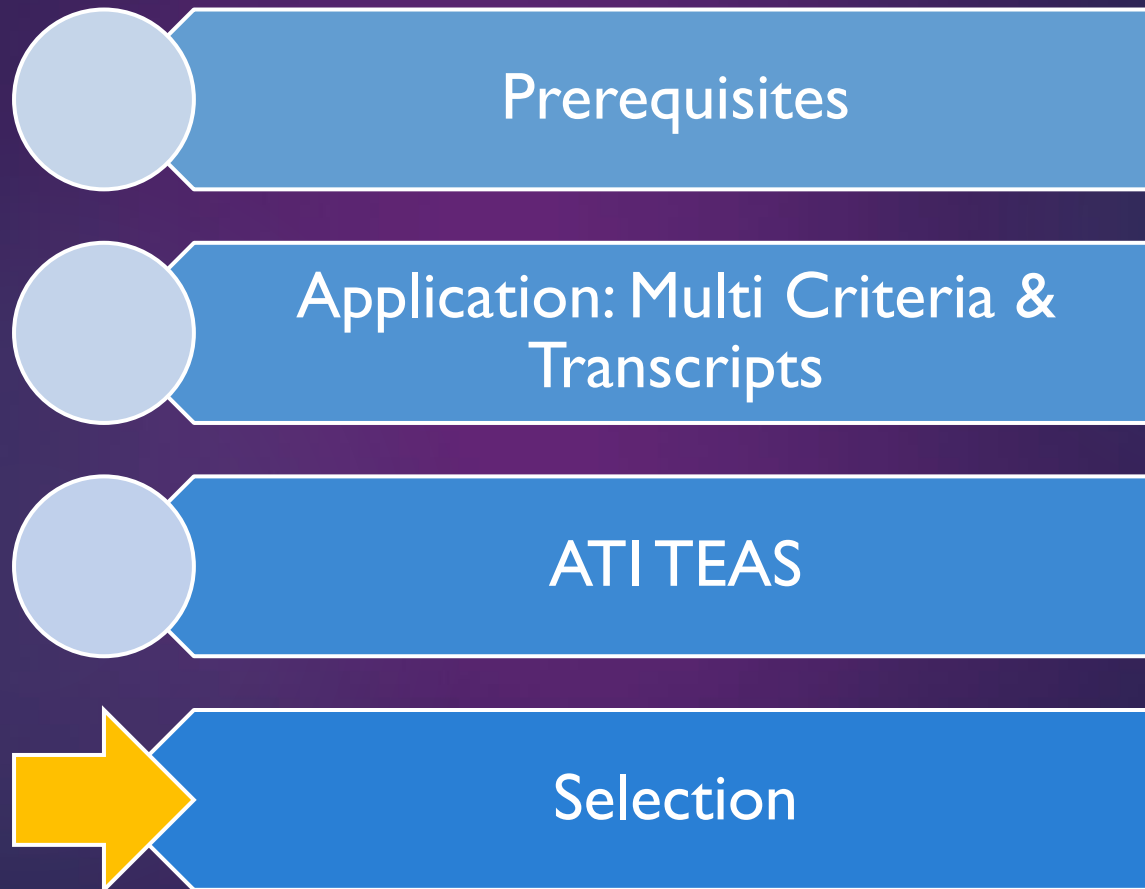
- ▶ Passed ATI TEAS: move forward to Selection
- ▶ Not Passed
 - ▶ Eligible for remediation, as available
 - ▶ Individualized plan to improve weak areas
 - ▶ Given up to one year to complete
 - ▶ If satisfactory, given another chance to take TEAS
 - ▶ Achieve minimum score in ALL areas

Selection for Admission

- ▶ Points applied to admission criteria, applicants ranked
- ▶ 50% admitted by multi-criteria process
 - ▶ In the event of a ranking tie that exceeds the number of vacancies, a random lottery will be conducted among those in that ranking
- ▶ 50% admitted by random lottery
- ▶ ***Check student email regularly***
 - ▶ Final status of eligibility will be sent via email only

Selection: Background Checks & Drug Testing

- ▶ To comply with the Joint Commission on the Accreditation of Healthcare Organizations and state and local regulations regarding background checks for healthcare providers, the following policy is hereby implemented by the Associate Degree Registered Nursing Directors of the Los Angeles Community Colleges:

- ▶ **Criminal Background Clearance and Urine Drug Screen:** All students must have completed a criminal background clearance/urine drug test and have proof of clearance prior to entering any nursing course with a clinical component. This includes local hospitals and health care agencies, including the county, community and private facilities. **Students who cannot present a clear background check will not be permitted to enter the nursing program. Students who test positive on a drug screen will not be able to continue in the nursing program** UNLESS a physician writes a note stating that prescription medications are causing the positive drug screen. Plan ahead to address any potential items that may appear on your background check. –LABC Student Handbook

Selection: Background Checks & Drug Testing

- ▶ **Plan ahead** to address any potential items that may appear on your background check
- ▶ Specific facilities may also require **Live Scan**
 - ▶ *Students who are denied clinical placement due to the inability to pass a required Live Scan will NOT be permitted to continue in the nursing program, unless an appropriate clinical placement can be found at an alternative agency. –Student Handbook 2017-2018*
